

USING THE KNOWLEDGE OF PERSONOLOGY IN LOOKING FOR YOUR IDEAL PARTNER



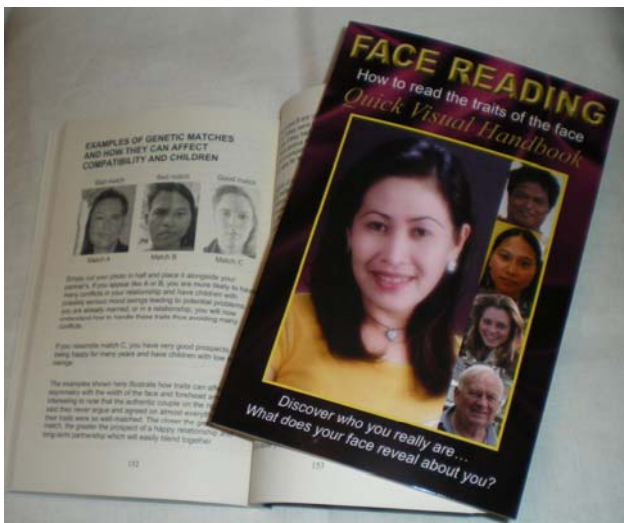
Do you know what to look for in your ideal partner, who will suit you and know what the six basic traits are which you should consider?
